## **Everking Mission & Vision**

## **STAFF JOB DESCRIPTION**

### **MINISTRY TEAM LEADER: SET-UP & TAKE-DOWN**

**PURPOSE:** The Oasis Set-Up & Take-Down Leader will serve to prepare the pre-and-post event logistical needs for Oasis and Special Events.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. At least 21 years of age, willing to agree to Standards of Conduct and Ministry Covenant.
2. A committed Christian with a definite sense of God's calling to ministry with students.
3. A person with a servant's spirit and gifting, who can organize, lead and work with individuals and groups to implement event logistical needs.
4. A person who has a desire to see youth won to faith in Christ and disciplined as believers of Christ.
5. A person who is a self-starter and team player and is motivated to work hard in the ministry to the Lord.

**DURATION:** One summer and academic year, as specified in Ministry Covenant.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

2. Work under the supervision of the Youth Pastor to provide leadership to the Set-Up and Take-Down Team, which will provide set-up and take-down needs (i.e., chairs, tables, game equipment) for Oasis and Special Events.
3. Will provide leadership to Youth Apprentice Team Member(s), youth, and adults who assist with team responsibilities and provide training, when needed.
4. Will work with Youth Apprentice Team Member(s) to recruit Set-Up and Take-Down Team Members.
5. Will make reasonable effort to attend Oasis three (3) times per month, and arrange for coverage when absent. Will make reasonable effort to attend Special Events.
6. Make reasonable effort to participate in Youth Staff Planning and Training meetings. Read (or listen to) assigned training materials.
7. Enforce Everking rules and expectations during Small Groups and Oasis (when present).
