## **Everking Mission & Vision**

**Mission (Purpose): REVEAL** who God is, **CONNECT** students to Jesus Christ and His family, and encourage students to **ADVANCE** the Kingdom of God in their everyday lives.

**Vision (Results):** God's plan for rescuing and sanctifying all nations will be told to the students of this community, and all who choose to follow God will be motivated to submit to His leadership and see victories in their daily effort to know and please Him.

## **STAFF JOB DESCRIPTION**

### **OASIS STAFF MEMBER**

**PURPOSE:** The Oasis Staff Member will serve under the supervision of the Youth Pastor and Ministry Team and Small Group Leaders to assist with Oasis program needs. The Oasis Staff Member will assist in an Oasis ministry team and/or Small Group of their choice, and provide structural support during Oasis. Personal availability to determine attendance at Oasis, but ideally serves twice (2) a month or more. Flexible commitment.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. At least 21 years of age, willing to agree to Standards of Conduct and Ministry Covenant.
2. A committed Christian with a definite sense of God's calling to ministry with students.
3. A person with spiritual "coaching" and serving gifts, who can organize, assist and work with individuals and groups to implement ministry objectives.
4. A person who has a desire to see youth won to faith in Christ and disciplined as believers of Christ.
5. A person who is a team player and is motivated to work hard in the ministry to the Lord.

**DURATION:** Duration flexible, pending personal availability, but ideally one academic year and summer. Duration to be specified in Ministry Covenant.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Work together with the Youth Pastor, Ministry Team Leaders and/or Small Group Leaders to assist Oasis program needs, such as set-up and take-down, hospitality, games, sound and media, and enforcing Oasis rules and expectations.
2. Actively engage students (specifically of the same gender) and take interest in their personal lives. Be available to listen, "coach," and even discipline, when appropriate.
3. Look for ways to assist the Oasis program. Encourage student participation in Oasis activities (e.g., games, ice-breakers) and ministry team needs (e.g., set-up and take down).
4. Work to make Oasis "the friendliest place in Hawaii Kai" by greeting all students by name and making an effort to remember names.
5. Make reasonable effort to participate in Youth Staff Planning and Training meetings. Read (or listen to) assigned training materials.
6. Enforce Everking rules and expectations during and Oasis and Special Events (when present).
7. Pray regularly for students and ministry.
