Everking Mission & Vision

Mission (Purpose): REVEAL who God is, **CONNECT** students to Jesus Christ and His family, and encourage students to **ADVANCE** the Kingdom of God in their everyday lives.

STAFF JOB DESCRIPTION

SMALL GROUP LEADER

PURPOSE: The Small Group Leader will serve to connect students to Jesus Christ and Christian peers in an intimate gender and age-specific group setting and encourage students to adopt essential beliefs and daily habits of a victorious Christian.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. At least 21 years of age, willing to agree to Standards of Conduct and Ministry Covenant.
2. A committed Christian with a definite sense of God's calling to ministry with students.
3. A person with spiritual "coaching" and teaching gifts, who can organize, lead and work with individuals and groups to implement ministry objectives.
4. A person who has a desire to see youth won to faith in Christ and disciplined as believers of Christ.
5. A person who is a self-starter and team player and is motivated to work hard in the ministry to the Lord.

DURATION: One summer and academic year, as specified in Ministry Covenant.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Work together with the Youth Pastor, Youth Staff and Small Group Co-leader in leading and teaching a gender and age-specific small group of students.
 - A. Leading and teaching one formal lesson every 4th Wednesday at Oasis' Small Group Night.
 - B. Lead one informal small group gathering away from the church campus between Small Group Nights (every 4 weeks).
2. Follow the teaching schedule and curriculum provided by the Youth Pastor for Small Group Nights.
3. Assist the Youth Staff during Oasis once per month, with special effort to build coaching relationship with small group youth.
4. Make personal contact with small group members between each Small Group Night. Gather personal contact information from small group visitors and make prompt follow-up contact.
5. Make reasonable effort to participate in Youth Staff Planning and Training meetings. Read (or listen to) assigned training materials.
6. Enforce Everking rules and expectations during Small Groups and Oasis (when present).
